Mathematics

Time – Months and years, hours in a day, telling the time to the minute, the 24hour clock, using a.m. and p.m., measuring time in seconds.

Measures & Data - Measuring in m, cm and mm. Tally charts, tables and bar charts. Finding the area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes. Coordinates.

Place Value - Negative numbers in context.

Multiplication & Division - Factors, multiples and mental multiplication.

Mental Mathematics strategies

Arithmetic & Reasoning questions practice.

Science

Habitats:

Living Things and Their Habitats - During this topic, the children will learn how to identify a range of British plants and animals, and how to classify organisms, including the use of classification keys. They will also consider why organisms live in different habitats and the impact, both positive and negative, that humans can have on environments.
